YEAR 7 VACCINATIONS

The Secondary School vaccine Program offers free4 vaccines to Year 7 students. These vaccines provide protection against:

- Diptheria, tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough) one dose
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) three doses
- Varicella (chicken pox) one dose

Parents/guardians of Year 7 students should look out for the vaccine consent card booklet coming home from school with your child. You need to read the booklet and complete and return Part A regardless of whether your child is being vaccinated at school.

The Hindmarsh Shire immunisation service may contact you about the Secondary School Vaccine Program. Schools are authorised to provide basic parent/guardian contact details to local councils for this purpose. Contact Ms. Clarke at school by 28th February 2017 if you do not want your contact details given to the Hindmarsh Shire immunisation service.

Scouts will start again on Tuesday 28th February.


