This year, in addition to the annual Attitudes to School Survey, all of our teachers surveyed all of the students in their classes, to gain valuable feedback on the students' perspective on the quality of the educational program. Each teacher received feedback on their students' perspective on areas such as high expectations for every student, a supportive and productive learning environment and rigorous assessment practices and feedback. As a staff we shared the results from the first round of PIVOT surveys and all teachers will undertake the survey again towards the end of the year.

We value student voice as a means to improving student **engagement, wellbeing, and quality instruction, and conducted** the survey to find out what your child thinks of our school. The Attitudes to School Survey is an annual student survey offered by the Department of Education and Training to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's schooling experience. The survey results will be reported back to the school before the end of term 2. All survey data that is made available in reports is for groups of students only so that no individual student can be identified. Data suppression rules are used for schools with low student numbers per year level.
