



The Rainbow Desert Enduro Committee are seeking volunteers to help at the upcoming Enduro on 9th/10th/11th August.


Volunteer positions include setting and cleaning up, ticket box sales, parking, recovery, helping to cook and serve hot chips and make coffee & tea.
