Student Wellbeing

Our school has a range of support mechanisms in place to ensure all of our students feel valued and we have a number of staff available to seek support from, if needed.

All students are part of an Avocadoes group that is comprised of one staff member and up to 7 students from a variety of year levels. Each week these groups meet and undertake a range of activities from general conversations to activities relating to the Character Strengths or other wellbeing activities. Throughout the year there are whole school activities where groups combine with their buddy group and get the opportunity to interact with other Avocado groups.

You may wonder where the name Avocadoes comes from. The initial concept was for each student to have a staff member as an advocate but what were the students to be known as? The story goes one of the students suggested that the students would be avocadoes and it has remained that way since.
