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Principal's Report from Mr Coffey

<u>2021 Planning</u>

The junior class configuration for next year has been finalised and would like to announce that in 2021 we will have a Prep class with Mrs. Veronica Huff, a Year 1/2 Class with Miss Downing, a Year 3/4 class shared between Mrs. Joan Solly and Miss Stef Newton and a Year 5/6 class led by the ever reliable Mrs. Valma Gregory.

The change in structure we trialled in the senior school this year has been successful in providing more opportunities for our senior students. This year we aligned the year 10 classes with the 6 VCE blocks thereby providing access to a range of VCE (Victorian Certificate of Education) subjects and VCAL (Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning) for our year 10 students.

In 2021 the secondary school will operate with year 7/8 and year 9/10 composite classes, once again providing a greater selection of subject choices and earlier pathways into VCE or VCAL, for our year 10 students.

In 2021 we are offering VCAL, 16 VCE subjects face to face and a further 3 VCE subjects via Distance Education which is excellent! In addition there are opportunities for VETis (Vocational Education and Training in Schools) school based apprenticeships, work placements and work experience. We are very proud of the choices available for our students and are fortunate to have the qualified and experienced staff to be able to offer these choices.

<u> Holiday Homework</u>

On Monday afternoon I joined a Webex session entitled Bricks and Mortar that detailed the guidelines associated with the capital works funding we will receive.

As mentioned in last week's newsletter there are 2 phases to the AMP (Asset Management Plan) with the purpose of phase 1 to describe the school's educational vision, direction and aspirations, and current facilities. There are 2 desired outcomes as part of phase 1

- To capture the education vision and direction of the school in terms of learning needs and aspirations
- Provide a high level overview of the current facilities in regard to <u>current</u> condition, functionality and sufficiency.

We were advised that AMP 1 is not about designing new Facilities, nor is it the time or place to be 'Bob the Builder' or 'Angie the Architect'. They will both be engaged as part of AMP 2.

All of the documentation for phase 1 needs to be completed by Thursday 4th of February. That is week 2 term 1 next year! As part of the project preparation we will need to seek feedback and ideas from our school community and this will be done via online surveys as there are exactly 17 school days remaining before the AMP Phase 1 has to be completed!

I will inform you via the school newsletter once the survey is available.

So how are we going to use the funding? That is unknown and will be shaped by the feedback and ideas forwarded by those who complete the survey.
