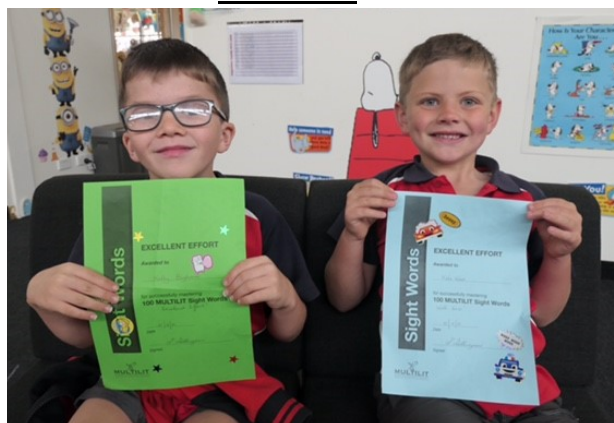

Great Victorian Bike Ride from Tessa Leach

Hello everyone,

Here is this week's skill session, this is the last skill session in the GVBR booklet. If you would like another copy of any of the skill sessions or have an idea of your own feel free to talk to me! Anyways, I hope you enjoy this week's session, it will help you with riding in and out of the seat while changing gears and turning.

What you will need:

- Cones or objects to mark distances on the ground
- Quiet street or open area (grass is fine too)

What you will do:

- Mark out a start line, then go forwards for a couple of meters, mark another place, forwards a couple meters then place another cone.
- Move to the side and place another cone then go back and mark out another line with cones parallel to the previous ones, mark out a finish line at the end

I know it's a bit complex but bear with me

- At the start ride towards the first marker, when you pass it change down a gear and pedal to the next cone
- Alternate in and out of the seat from the two turning cones as you turn
- On the way out of the turn change back up a gear at the marker and pedal to the finish line

If this is too easy:

- Weave in and out of the gear changing cones
- Set up the course as a figure 8
- Find a hilly road or maybe some grass

Sorry, there is no option for if this is too difficult, just keep practicing!!

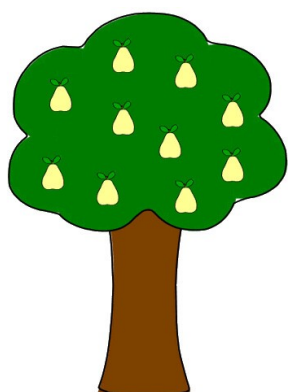
