The school has a good supply of masks and RAT tests that are available at any time.

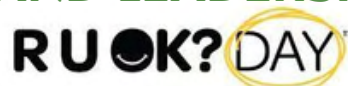

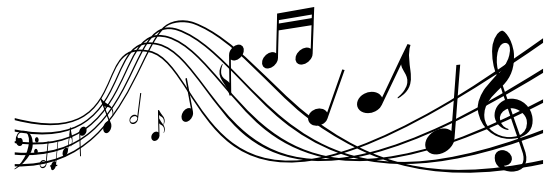

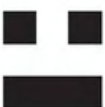
