Students are expected to come straight to the Rainbow Pool at <u>8:40am</u> for an 8:50am start. Buses will be dropping off and picking up students straight from the pool.

Sunscreen is provided by the school, however, if you child has a sensitivity please bring some from home.

The pool canteen will be open and there will be a BBQ for lunch.

Lunch break will be approximately at 12:30pm. But we encourage students to eat during breaks within their program.

Students are to remain in house areas at ALL times to ensure that the swimming program runs smoothly.
